Rules and Guidelines

2. Each team shall consist of four players whose playing handicap is added together and divided by ten to arrive at the number of strokes to be deducted from the gross score of the team.

MAXIMUM HANDICAP 20

Example	Handicap
Player 1	15
Player 2	12
Player 3	20
Player 4	20
TOTAL	67

Therefore 6.7 strokes shall be deducted from the final gross score of the team. (Fractions of shots DO apply)

3. All four players shall tee off at each hole and the location of the ball deemed to be in the best position shall be marked, using a tee or a similar object. Each player shall then play a second shot from this point.

NB. If the ball lies on the fairway the ball can be placed within six inches of the marker, not nearer the hole.

If the ball lies in the rough or in a hazard, the ball shall be dropped within one club length of the marker, again not nearer to the hole.

3. Subsequent shots shall be played in the same manner as in item 2 above until such time as the ball is holed out.

NB. Take care not to tap in a short putt when your partner can still hole a 25 footer !!!!

4. One score per hole shall be entered on the score card in the player A column and the completed card shall be totalled, have the handicap allowance deducted and then be signed by two of the three players.
